

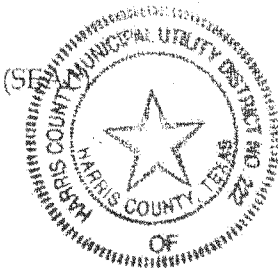

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 222 will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, April 18, 2019, at 11:30 a.m., at 13430 Northwest Freeway, Suite 700, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve Minutes.
2. Input/inquiries from District customers.
3. Update on Caldwell development project in the District.
4. Landscaping in the District, including:
 - a. improvements to District property and recreational facilities; and
 - b. CenterPoint Energy substation.
5. District security.
6. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills, and review of investments.
8. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, and water accountability.
9. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
10. Review Drought Contingency Plan and Adopt Order Adopting Amended and Restated Drought Contingency Plan.
11. Approve engineer's report, including:
 - a. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters;
 - b. drainage overflow from Wortham Falls;
 - c. waterline portion of Wortham Boulevard culvert headwall reconstruction; and
 - d. other engineering matters.
12. Matters relating to North Harris County Regional Water Authority, including pumpage fees, surface water conversion program and issuance of bonds.
